



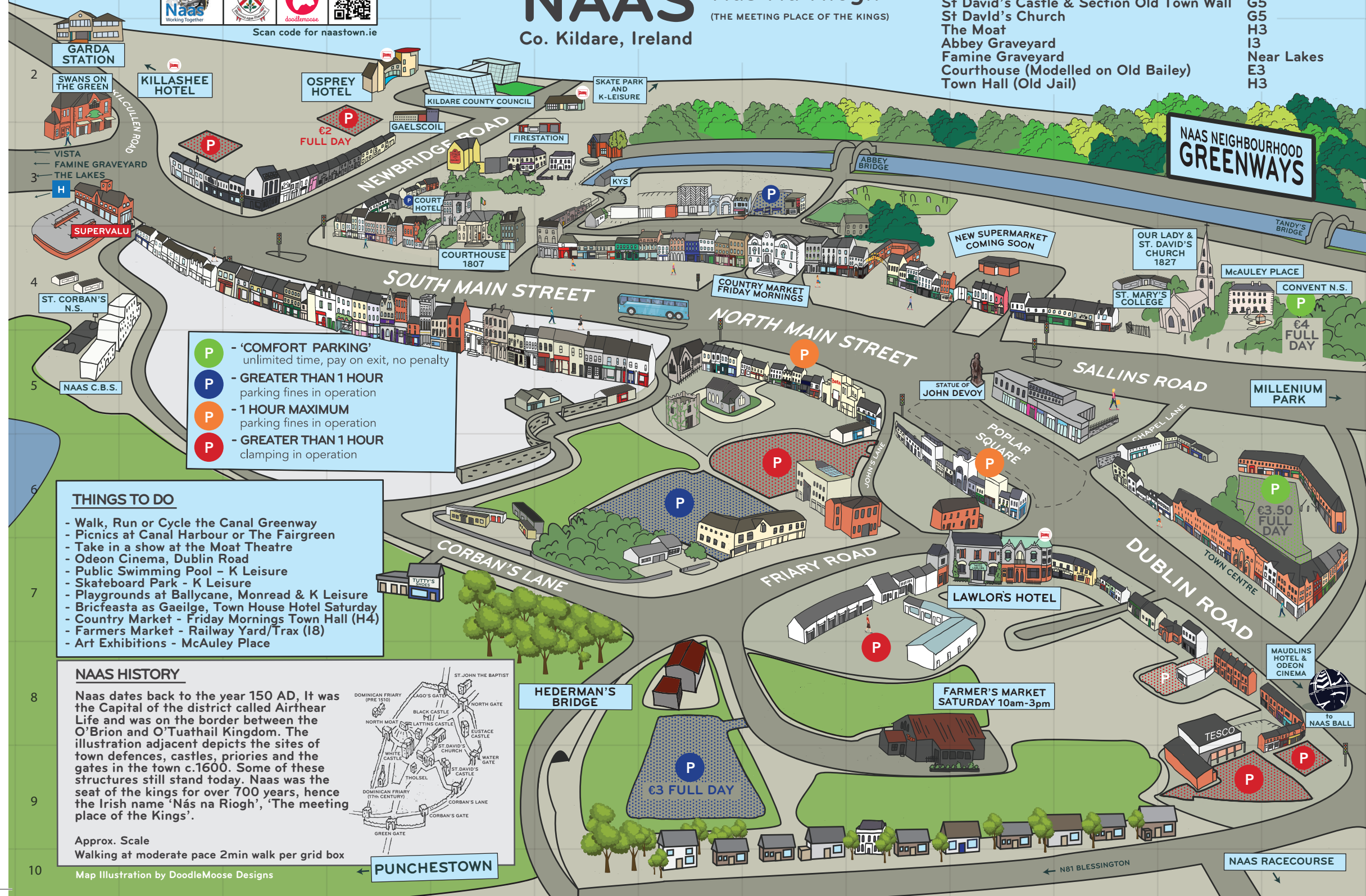

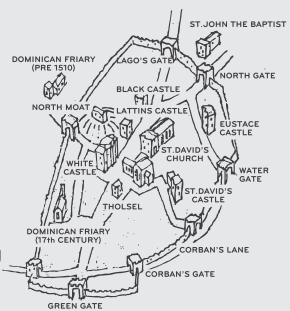

NAAS HISTORY

Naas dates back to the year 150 AD. It was the Capital of the district called Airtheall Life and was on the border between the O'Brion and O'Tuathail Kingdom. The illustration adjacent depicts the sites of town defences, castles, priories and the gates in the town c.1600. Some of these structures still stand today. Naas was the seat of the kings for over 700 years, hence the Irish name 'Nás na Riogh', 'The meeting place of the Kings'.
